

# HISTORY OF FOOTBALL



Football was played by the first time in Egypt, as part(report) of a rite by the fertility, during the 3rd century B.C.. The ball of leather was invented by the Chinese in the 4th century B.C.. The Chinese were refilling these balls with sows. The first thing that was done by her(it) was simply to play to pasarla. They did not use it in championships.

In the Middle Ages there were many gentlemen obsessed with the games with ball, being prohibited by his(her,your) violent character .

On May 26, 1928, the Congress of the FIFA, located in Amsterdam, decided, to organize a competition (the World Cup) of all the affiliated nations. In 1930 the First World Championship of Football is realized in Uruguay. The Uruguayan Selection The First World Champion of Football goes out, after conquering to the Selection Argentina for 4 to 2.

Of the points more resaltantes of the history of the World Cup we have as country that has been present in all the final phases from 1930, to Brazil, with a whole of 15 times.

Between(Among) out-standing prominent figures this Fontaine, Frenchman who has the record of more goals marked during a final phase, obtained in the world one of Sweden in 1958 and the Brazilian known since(as,like) Peel as the player that has taken part(informed) and cattle in three World Glasses, 1958, 1962 and 1970.
